Augustus Caesar (27 BCE – 14 CE) was the name of the first and, by most accounts, greatest Roman emperor. Augustus was born Gaius Octavius Thurinus on 23 September 63 BCE. Octavian was adopted by his great-uncle Julius Caesar in 44 BCE, and then took the name Gaius Julius Caesar. In 27 BCE the Senate awarded him the honorific Augustus ("the illustrious one"), and he was then known as Gaius ... The term "tetrarchy" (from the Greek: τετραρχία, tetrarchia, "leadership of four [people]") describes any form of government where power is divided among four individuals, but in modern usage usually refers to the system instituted by Roman Emperor Diocletian in 293, marking the end of the Crisis of the Third Century and the recovery of the Roman Empire. Generic Timeline of the Empire. 753 BC – the founding of Rome by Romulus Rome ruled by Monarchy . Circa 500 BC – Tarquin the Mad caused Romans to fear the possibility of being ruled by a single leader. Republic rounded – Senate w/ 300 men. 44 BC – Julius Caesar assassinated, civil war, Octavian takes over rule. Circa 27 BC – arguably, the beginning of the Empire
